



MyVoice	Students can provide real-time feedback during the final minutes of classes. At the beginning of the semester, the supervisor, the lecturer, and the course supervisor put together a series of questions that will run throughout the semester. The lecturer has access to the interface, where additional questions can be entered at any time during the semester.
