






Accommodation services for international students at ELTE were launched in September 2016 as the several times since then. Currently it consists of two complementary areas, which also work in synergy at the level of student administration

PROVIDING DORMITORY ACCOMMODATION AND HOUSING SERVICES.



Applications in both areas are already accepted from May, before university admission. Based on the decision about the scholarship, the dormitory places can already be distributed in the first half of July. Accepted students will be provided with a temporary accommodation certificate including the address of the dormitory in the admission letter. This makes applications for visa much faster and less stressful for students.
